**Your \$25 registration fee is required to reserve your spot prior to Saturday, 25 February.**

## **Event schedule:**

Event start time: 12:00pm

Voting ends: 3:00pm

People's Choice Award presentation: 3:30pm

Event end time: 4:00pm

Break-down: 4-5pm

## **Items provided:**

- Spoons
- Napkins
- Sample cups (3oz)
- 10x10 ft space (Please set up in designated area)
- Hand sanitizer
- 4 Chili Cook-off t-shirts
- Booth number

## **You must provide:**

- Tent (10x10 ft limit)
- Table
- Chairs
- Food heaters
- Cooking and serving supplies
- Team to help (no max)
- If you will be warming food with an open flame, you are required to bring a fire extinguisher.
- Cooler (if needed - no outside alcohol permitted)
- Signage for your restaurant, business, or team (optional)



# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## Set-up:

Set-up begins at 10:30am. You **must** check in at the welcome booth in order to confirm registration and receive your booth location. Booth locations are on a first come, first serve basis **after** check in.

## Chili:

We recommend bringing your chili warm and ready to serve as cooking on-site may be difficult. You are required to provide **300 portions** for sampling. Three ounce tasting cups will be provided, but we recommend only filling cups halfway to ensure your chili lasts the entirety of the event.

## How voting works:

The winning chili will be selected by People's Choice voting. Each event attendee will need to purchase a sampling ticket upon entry in order to sample your chili and vote. Once they have sampled your chili, you **must** highlight your booth number on their card. (No attendee is permitted more than one sample, unless they purchase an additional sampling ticket).

## Safety requirements:

All booths with an open flame must have a fire extinguisher. A safety waiver and sanitation agreement will be provided at check-in that all teams must sign in order to compete.

## Breakdown:

Each team is responsible for breakdown of their station and removal of all trash. Trash bins will be available throughout the area to ensure a convenient clean up process. Any equipment left on site will be left at owners expense and Compass Media does not take responsibility for lost or abandoned items.

## People's Choice Award:

At 3pm, all sampling tickets submitted to voting stations will be counted and the winning chili will be announced at 3:30pm. The winner will receive the Chili Cook-off trophy (on loan for the year), a plaque (to keep) and \$1,500 KYD cash! Upon receiving the trophy, the winner must complete the Trophy on Loan agreement in order to leave the property with the trophy.

All registration and sample ticket proceeds will be going to Lighthouse School and Cayman Islands Little League.
